Read Ephesians 6:10-24

Q1. Paul ends his letter to the church in Ephesus by reminding them that they are living out their Christian life in the middle of a spiritual battle. How do you understand that term 'spiritual battle'. Who are the opponents and what are they fighting over?

Q2. Paul makes it clear that we are not bystanders in this battle but as followers of Jesus we are involved, in fact it is our souls that are being fought over and our very lives that are the battle ground? What are you doing to protect your own soul from the enemy?

Q3. Verse 11 says that we can stand firm against all the strategies of the enemy. Paul in this book has taught that the demonic realm is constantly scheming to force a division between you and God. What strategies has he employed against you?

Q4. Darren said in his sermon that Satan wants to steal, kill and destroy. He wants to steal away your relationship with God, kill your identity in Christ and destroy as much as possible, he's not concerned about any 'collateral damage' in fact he delights in weaponising you. What do you make of Darren's statement, can you see evidence of this in the world.

Q5. How do you feel about your part in the battle? Paul says we have to put on the full armour of God. We actually have to do something to protect ourselves, otherwise we will not make it to the end.

Q6. One of the cardinal rules of warfare is to know your enemy. The better we know what we are up against, the more likely we are to recognize how and when the enemy attacks and the more likely we will be able to resist. If you were a demonic commander assigned to launch an attack against you where would you concentrate your assault? Share this with the group, as tough as that might be, and then put Ephesians 6:18 into practice.
