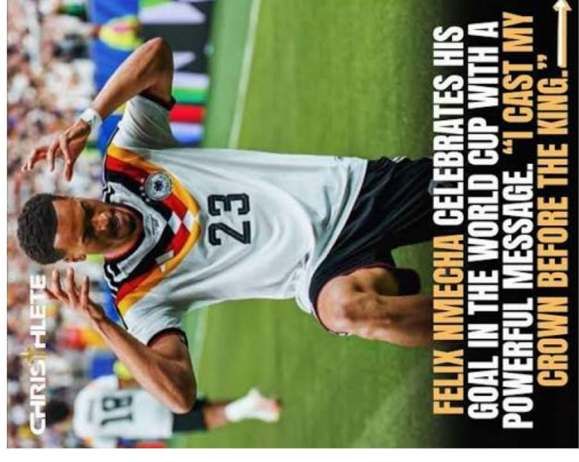

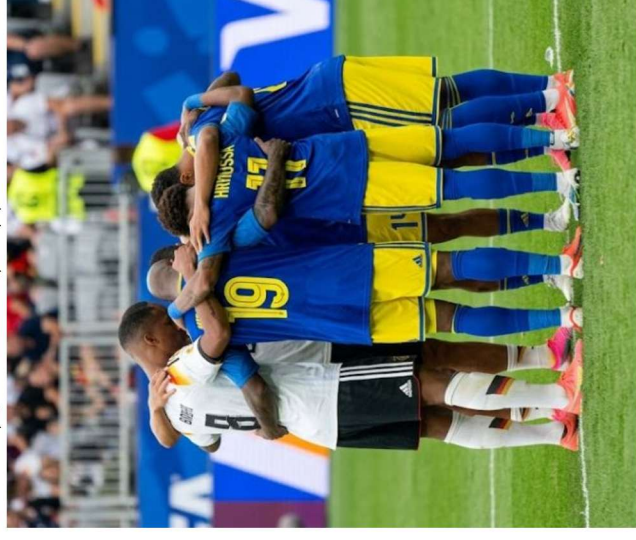
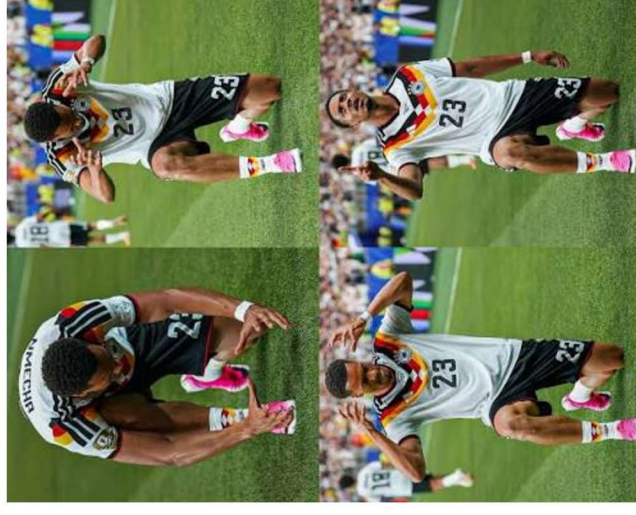
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Jesus is King

John Drama Information

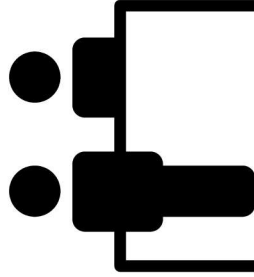

Touch Point

Holy Spirit

Q1. Were you aware that God had emotions and feelings? What kind of things do you imagine will impact his feelings and why?

Read Ephesians 4:30-32 NLT

Q2. The context of Paul's teaching about grieving the Holy Spirit is human relationships. Why does the way we treat others cause the Spirit to grieve?

Q3. What does a 'grieving' Holy Spirit tell us about the character of God?

Q4. Does knowing that your behaviour towards others can impact God's heart negatively, impact your behaviour? Should it?

Q5. In Ephesians 4:30 NLT it says that 'God has identified you as his own'. How has he done that for you? How do you know you belong to him?

Darren talked about being an image bearer. If we are made in God's image and filled with His spirit we should reflect his character. If we are not then we are declaring something about God that he is not. That is why Jesus had to deal with our image problem, we cannot display the Godly image as we should but in Christ that burden is removed. Jesus has our image problem covered because the Father looks at us and sees Jesus.

Q6. Are there ways that you know that you have grieved the Spirit. Maybe it's time to tell him how sorry you are and seek reconciliation with whoever you have hurt. Maybe today is the day to change the way the Holy Spirit is feeling?
